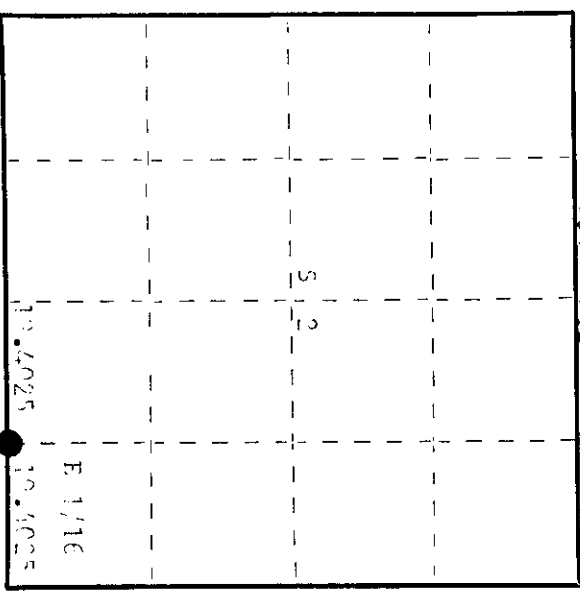
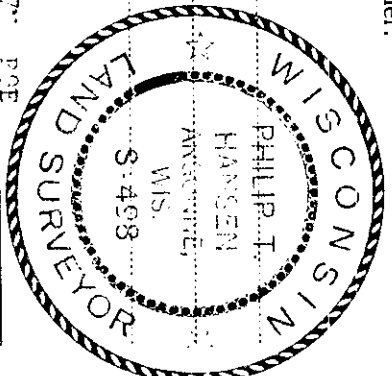

Hansen, do hereby certify that on the 10th day of September, 1977, I found evidence of the E 1/16 corner of Section 2 & 11 Township 37, North, Range 9 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Drivers and crew, Pipeco Surveyors, in 1922. Fan Range line S 87° 33' 40" W a distance of 27.88 chains, deflected right 171° 49' 50" a distance of .935 chains to S 1 1/4 corner. Computed distance 38.705 chains at bearing S 87° 45' 30" W. Set E 1/16 interredible at 10.4025 chains.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered 1st Iron pipe with a 2nd brass cap, projecting 3/4" above ground. Cap stamped: Monument recovered in good condition. Also recovered an old square cedar post, 12" x 6" x 24" (Hwy), scribed 1/2" - 1/2", with old barometer scribbled 1/2" W 17' 10" (Hwy) S 70° W 20' 11" (Hwy). Recovered 2nd pipe (not recorded). Third survey to 1000', 11.4 1/2" (Hwy), set back 1/16 pt. Made Service for the south 10.1 1/2" (Hwy), set back 1/16 pt. E 1/16 S 1/2 1/16 2110

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Monument was left as recovered. No additional accessories established.
