Rein do hereby certify that on the 10th day of October, 1979, I found evidence of the one-quarter corner of between sections 4 and 5 Township 37 North, Range 9 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:

wood post set by William W. Daugherty, Deputy Surveyor on September 1st, 1863, witnessed by a 15" white pine bearing S34°E, 38 lks (25.08 feet) and by a 10" Y. Pine bearing N29°W, 316 lks (208.56 feet)

Description of corner evidence found: recovered Point of rotted Cedar Post and 1/2" diameter iron rod with curved top found in swamp.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the location of this corner:

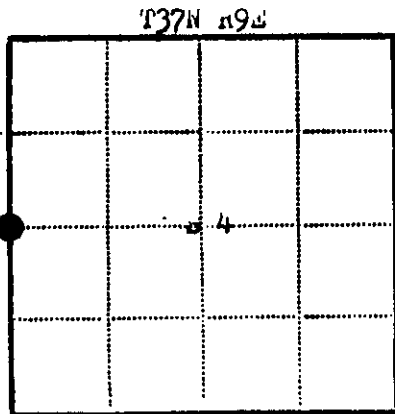
replaced point of rotted Cedar Post with an Aluminum Oneida County Survey marker, witnessed by the following scribed bearing trees with P.A. nails set in lower blaze-

- 4" Tamarack N1°E, 46.74 feet
8" Tamarack S16°W, 59.97 feet
10" Norway Pine S62°E, 86.31 feet
