**THIS CORNER RECOVERED AND PERPETUATED AT THE REQUEST AND APPROVAL OF ONEIDA COUNTY SURVEYOR MICHAEL ROMPORTL SUBSEQUENT TO PREVIOUS HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT BY ONEIDA COUNTY.**

No record monument was observed nor detected with magnetic metal locator at this corner location within existing highway pavement area, so I reestablished the corner with a 7/16" dia. by 8" long galvanized spike driven flush with the pavement surface in accordance with 1973 Wisconsin DOT Preservation of Landmark record by Hess, RLS 666, filed as L-479 in Oneida County records. The corner falls 1.3' North of the South edge of 22' wide pavement.

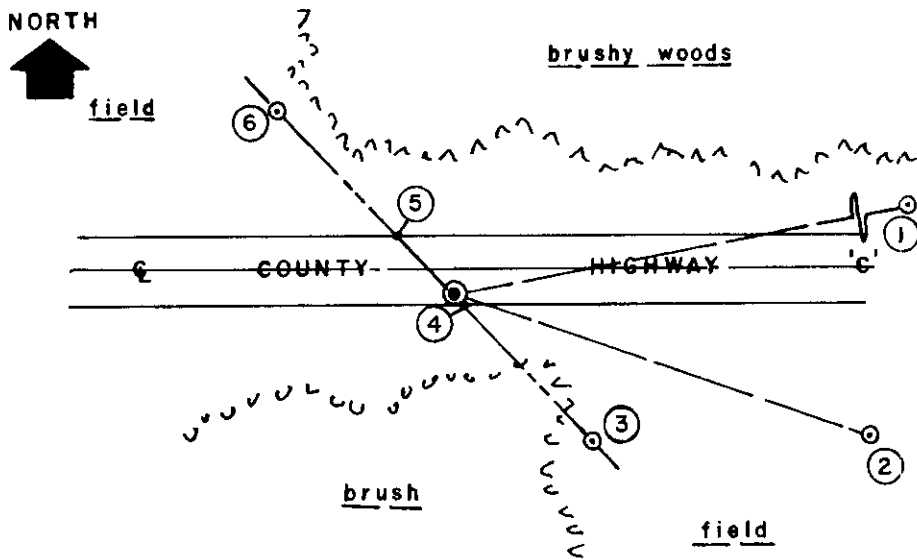
I recovered all four(4) cast aluminum monuments with standard stamped Wis DOT cap undisturbed for corner location reestablishment purposes, which I set by proportion on a right line with transit between found witness monuments 3 and 6 noted below.

I left all reference monument caps open and flagged with blaze orange, and check measured all Wis DOT record tie distances except between witness monuments at 1 and 6 due to thick brushy conditions.

I set a standard white poly 'T' marker post 6" south of witness monument 6, 6" North of witness monument 3 and 17.5' South of spike at corner location.

This recovery completed August 25, 1999; there were no direct witnesses other than frequent vehicle drive-bys.

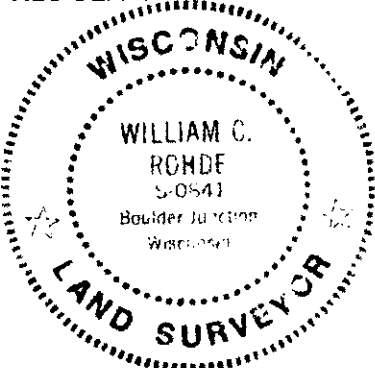
**WITNESS MONUMENT TIES:**

- ① Standard Wis DOT capped cast aluminum monument found 5' below grade N78°13'E 208.78' per record.
- ② Standard Wis DOT capped cast aluminum monument found flush S71°56'E 135.88' per record.
- ③ Standard Wis DOT capped cast aluminum monument found 5' below grade S43°15'E 62.51'(62.55' record).
- ④ 1/4" dia. by 2.5" long PK nail set at edge of pavement on right line.
- ⑤ Standard Wis DOT capped cast aluminum monument found 3" below grade N43°15'W 81.19'(81.25' record)
- ⑥ Standard Wis DOT capped cast aluminum monument found 5' below grade N78°13'E 208.78' per record.

Unless otherwise indicated, all bearing tree ties are to a .25" dia. by 2.5" long PK nail with a 1.25" dia. steel washer driven into unblazed right face and a .25" dia. by 2.5" long PK nail with a 2" dia. steel washer stamped BT is also driven into unblazed face of bearing tree at DBH; the basis for measured bearings is by compass to nearest degree and all tie distances are measured horizontal by steel tape corrected to nearest 1/100th feet at standard temperature of 68° F.

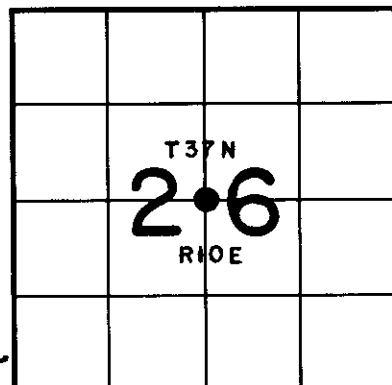
