I Elwood L. Olson, do hereby certify that on the 18th day of April, 1968, I found evidence of the One Quarter corner of Sections 1 and 6 Township 38 North, Range 3 and 4 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:

Original corner established in 1864 by Alex Anderson, Government Deputy Surveyor.  
Cedar 9 S10W, 8 links.  
Cedar 16 N67E, 8 links.

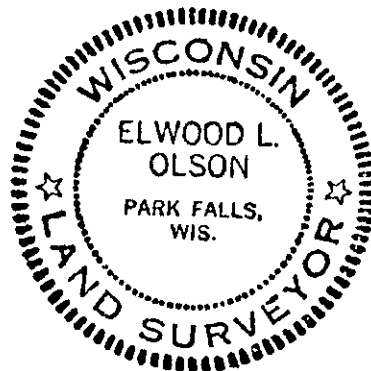
From 874-9 corner record by Harry L. Sykes, U.S. Forest Service, dated 1-6-1936:  
Corner marked by Cedar post (good condition) Line N.-S. cut out 4 feet wide.  
Original Cedar bearing tree down, N67°E, 12 links, blaze decayed, only 1/4 marks visible.  
Balsam 6", East, 10 feet (location poster)

Description of corner evidence found:

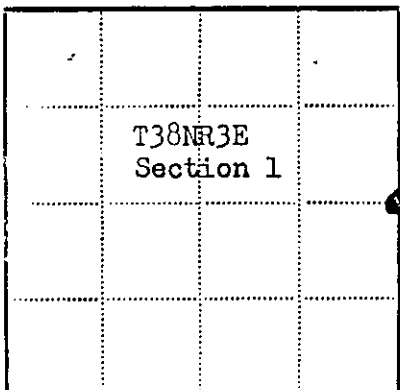
Corner marked by old 3 inch squared cedar post marked "1/4, S6, 1/4, S1" extending 30" above swamp level. Found Sykes location poster on a dead Balsam bearing N76°E, 9.7 feet from corner post. The post is on an old N.-S. cut out line and in a Cedar swamp. From corner, I measure 85 feet south to a 2 ft. wide creek (partly underground) which runs east.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of old post set 2" dia., 5' long, flanged bottom, concrete filled, galvanized wrought iron pipe, extending 12" above swamp level, with 3" bronze tablet on top stamped: T38N,R3E,R4E, 1/4, S1, S6, S.785, 1968.  
Blazed and scribed new bearing trees as follows:  
Cedar 10", N49°E, 14.9 feet.  
Cedar 8", S78°W, 28.8 feet.  
Cedar 8", N22°W, 48.1 feet.  
Iron sign post, South, 1.6 feet.
