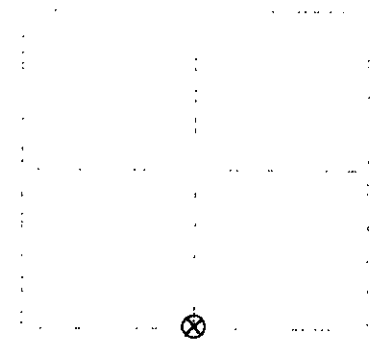

October, 1880: Alexander Anderson, US deputy surveyor notes the following: 40.40 set 1/4 sec. post: aspen 6 N46W, 56 ft., aspen 6 N46E, 34 ft.

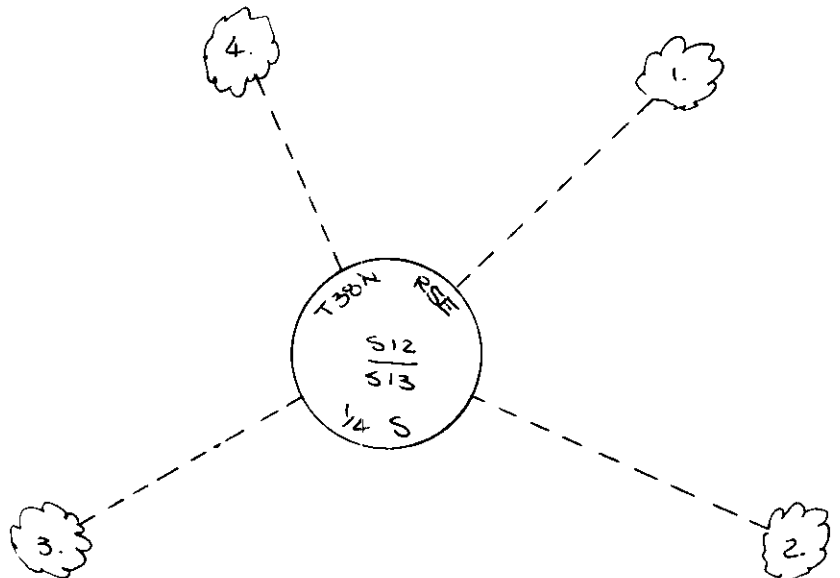
April 15, 1888: US map, page 22 notes the following: 40.260 corrected 6.072 for 1/4 S. Should be corrected N. 10.5 on. 1/4-40 set 1/4 sec. post: 1/4 W, 1/4 E, 1/4 S, 1/4 N. 1888: page 5 564-1 W, 1/4 S.

February 3, 1970: I found and accepted a 20" pine stump post with iron cap 1" above ground marked as shown below. I found the following witness posts: pine stump (100) S46E, 32.12 feet; jack pine dead (100) 111 S60W, 74.11 feet. I established the following witness posts: set nail in aspen 7" N24W, 7.79 feet; set nail in aspen 7" N46E, 32.96 feet; set nail in gray w. spruce 7" S66E, 11.83 feet; set nail in pine 20" S60W, 74.87 feet; set plastic sign post 4 feet.

General: This view of corner with ties to at least four witness monuments. If in disagreement with previously established corner, show the distances between the two corners and also indicate the tie to the disputed corner.

1. nail in aspen 7" N46E, 32.96 feet.
2. nail in w.spruce 7" S66E, 11.83 feet.
3. nail in n.pine 20" S60W, 74.87 feet.
4. nail in aspen 7" N24W, 7.79 feet.
