

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RESTORATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by Al Xavier Anderson on October 4th, 1863, marked by a wood post, witnessed by a 3" Tamarack bearing S71-1/2°E, 18 links (11.88 feet) and by a 1 1/2" Tamarack bearing S41-1/2°W, 8 links (5.28 feet)

I, James L. Rein, do hereby certify that on the 22nd day of December, 1978, I found evidence of the East one-quarter corner of Section 31

of Township 38 North, Range 2 East, Fourth Principal Meridian,

as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Resident witnesses:

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a very rusted 1-1/4" diameter x 27" long iron pipe flush and 4-1/2" square Spruce post up 30" in swamp from which a 1 1/2" Tamarack stub up 5 feet with a portion of scribbling visible on both upper and lower blazes bears S110-30' E, 2.24 feet; an 8" Tamarack stub up 5 feet with a portion of scribbling visible on upper blaze, no lower blaze visible, stub bears S110-21' E, 8.05 feet. Both of the above stubs have approximately one inch of overgrowth around edges of blazes.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Set a 2" diameter x 30" long Fasten monument with a 3-1/2" diameter cast aluminum Oneida County cap up 6" to replace 1-1/4" diameter iron pipe. Corner is located in a Black Spruce swamp 66 feet North of South edge and 60 feet East of west edge. Made bearing trees to corner:
P.K. nail in a scribed 2" White Pine bears S120-11' E, 97.02 feet;
P.K. nail in a scribed 4" Black Spruce bears S50-27' E, 26.00 feet;
P.K. nail in a scribed 5" Black Spruce bears S30-42' W, 33.18 feet.

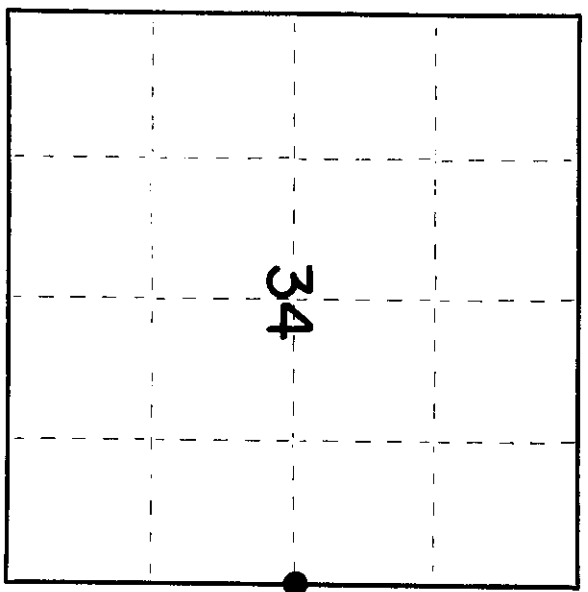

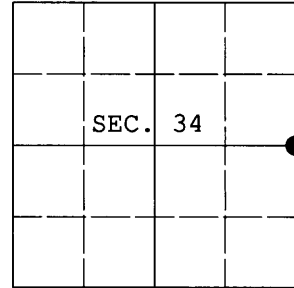

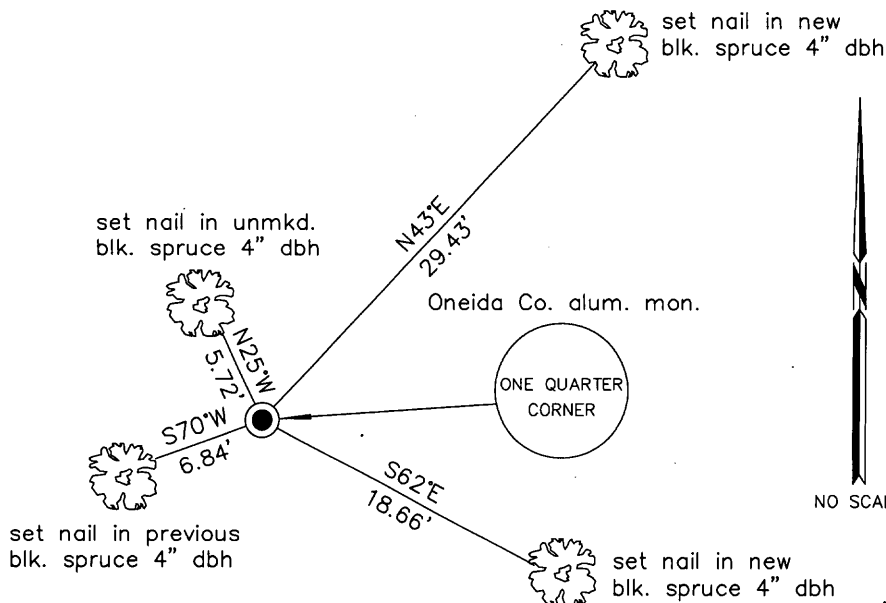

NOTE: This is a perpetuation of a previous USPLS Monument Record by James D. Rein, RLS dated December 26, 1978 and filed in the office of the Oneida County Register of Deeds. A complete history of the corner can be found on the previous monument record. I accept the previous location as a true and faithful perpetuation or reestablishment of the original corner location and further perpetuate it as follows.

November 15, 2010: I found and accepted Rein's monument, a 2-1/2" diam. aluminum post with Oneida Co. aluminum cap projecting 6" above the bog and marked as shown below. I found a blk. spruce standing dead at S10°E, 26 ft., Rein's other trees are gone. I established accessories as shown below and set a white plastic sign post bearing West, 1 ft. dist.


