

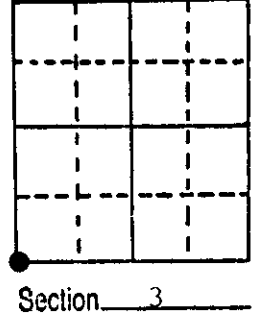
U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

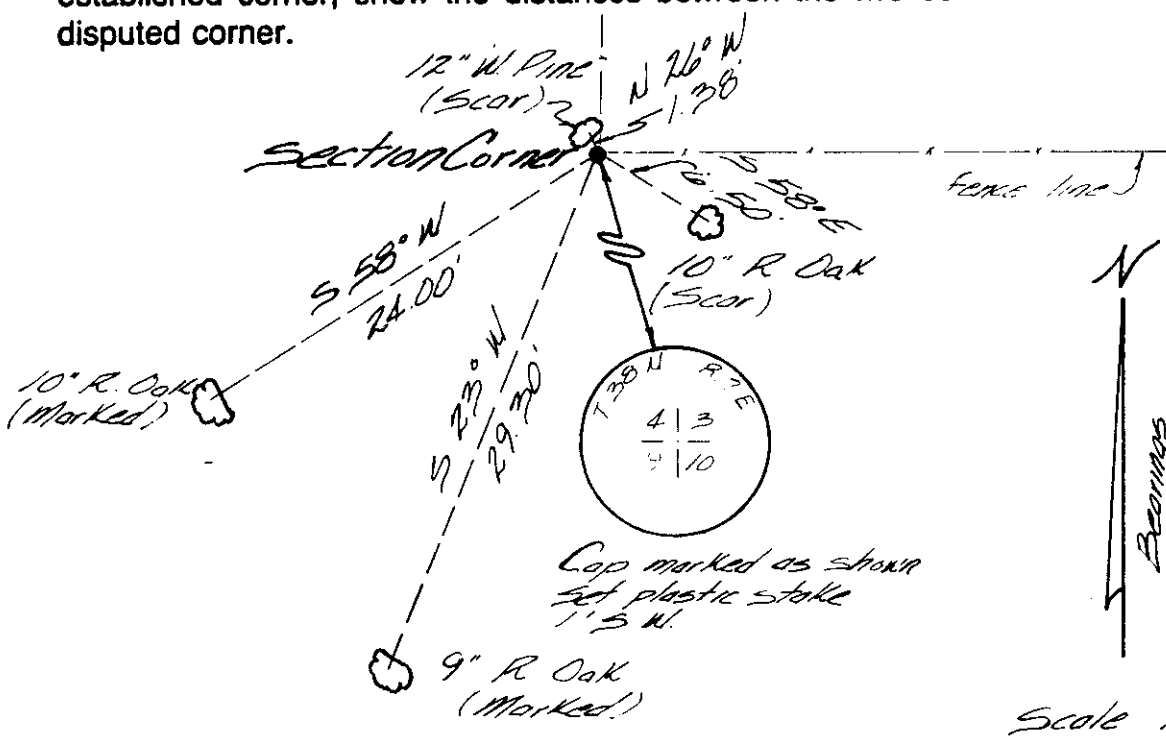

August 1863 - Alexander Anderson (Deputy Surveyor) Set post for Corner to Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10. Bearing trees: 10" Birch S30½°W, 24 links; 10" Maple, N42°E, 19 links.
 November 22, 1892 - B. F. Dorr - Found SE Section Corner of Section 4
 March 1947 - A. J. Lytle - 40.82 chains from S¼ Corner Section 3 found Corner Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10.
 March 1958 - E. F. Kowalke - Found brass cap iron pipe. Bearing trees: W. Pine 6", N55°W, 0.8'; Oak 8", N70°W, 18.6 feet; Oak 6", S55°E, 6.3 feet.
 February 9th, 1988 - James D. Rein, RLS - Found brass capped 2" dia. iron pipe and existing bearing trees as shown below in plan view.
 Note: Distance measurements made to aluminum nails set in center of root crown on side of tree facing corner.

(c) (d) (e) Plan view of corner with ties to at least 4 witness monuments. If in disagreement with previously established corner, show the distances between the two corners and also indicate the ties to the disputed corner.



Note: All bearing trees are existing.
