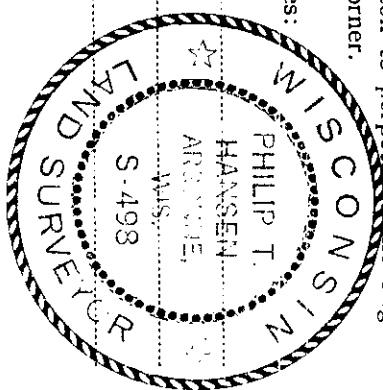

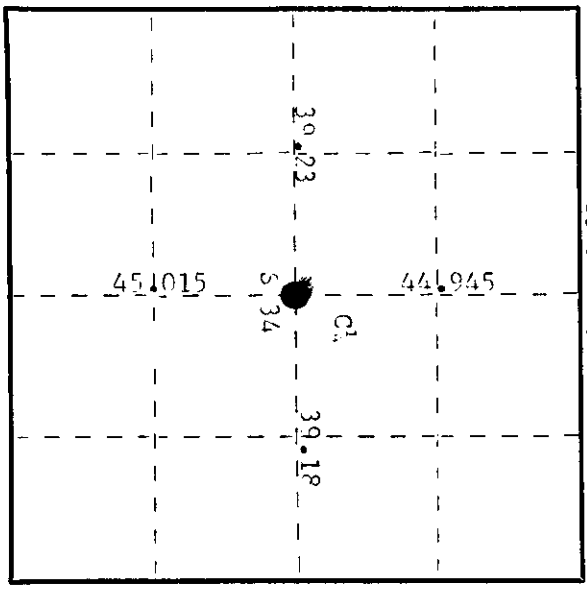

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by N. Loftus, Pisco surveyor, in 1960. Ran E-W and N-S 1/4 line to establish the C 1/4 corner at intersection. Set iron pipe and marked NBTs - White Pine 7" S24°W, 35' links and White Spruce 7" N85°W, 35' links.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered 2" iron pipe with 3" square brass cap, projecting 30" above ground. Cap stamped: Recovered CRTs - White Pine 7" (10") S24°W, 35' links. White Spruce 7" N85°W, 35' links, now stump only. T39P R9F Cl S34 PTCC

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

As monument was securely in ground, it was left as recovered. Marked PPTS - Red Pine 12" N80°E, 34.0 links, scribed Cl PT. White Pine 9" N48°E, 63.5 links, scribed Cl PT.
