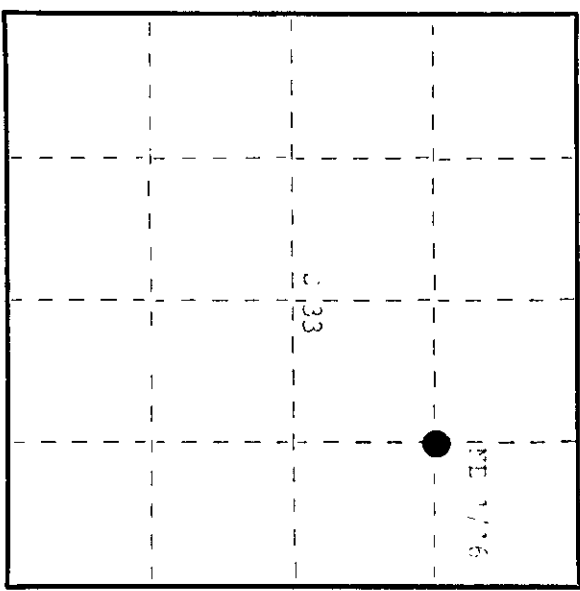
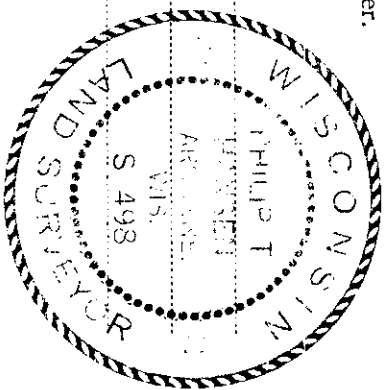

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by W. Loftus, Tippecanoe Surveyor, in 1856. Far north line 56' 30" E from previously established R 1/4 E corner of north line, 37.715 chains, to close out 1st line west of EC 1/4 E corner. Set NE 1/4 corner at 18.957' chains, interpolate on true line. Corrected bearing 86° 30' E. Marked with - Sugar Maple 20' 05" 23' 9" links Yellow Birch 6" 18" E, 57' links

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered 2nd Iron pipe with 70' square base cap, stamped: Monument 18' 1/2' above ground, recovered in excellent condition. Recovered CRTS - Sugar Maple 20' 05" (110' 55" (N170°E) 8' 0" links (6.7 lbs) Yellow Birch 6" 18" (65' 0") 25' 0" links, from 1st line (18.957').

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Monument was left as recovered. Monument - Sugar Maple 20' 05" 23' 9" links, set on 1/4 E 1/4 NE.
