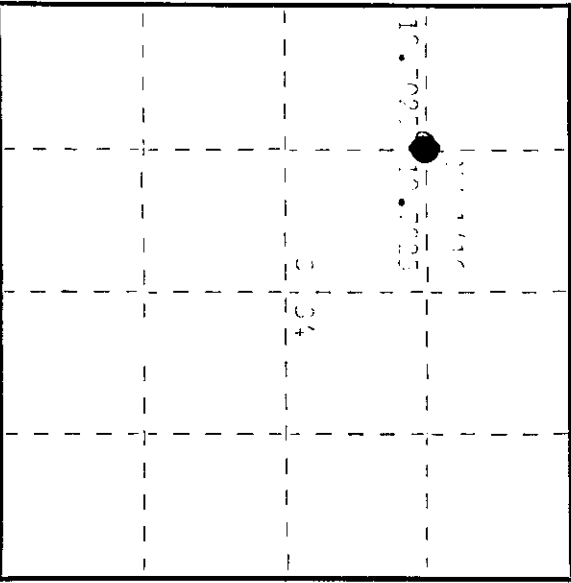
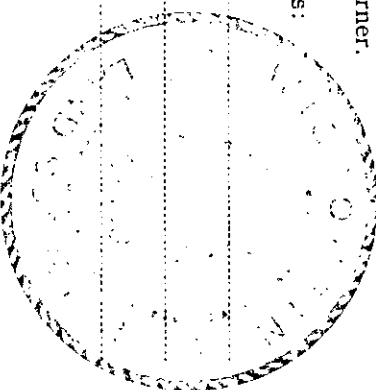

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Drivas and crew, Bruce Carvey, Jr., in 1924. Prior to 1924 established on 1/16 part of 1/4 section, dist. not 10.706 of line. Distance west 0.703 chains. 2000 feet. Corrected distance 10.703 chains, bearing line 60° 27' 00" from N 1/4 to N 1/2 line 36.703 chains. Close out to line south of N 1/16. Section 1/16 of 10.703 chains. Line 6.1125 north. 10.703 chains. 171 1/2 feet.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered 3/77 from site with 20 square inches and 1/2 inch diameter. 2000 above ground. 24 square feet. Recovered CB's - 1/16 to 1/4, 10.703 chains, 171 1/2 feet, 6.1125 north. 10.703 chains. 171 1/2 feet.
